Darrell and Ann had one daughter, Patricia Ann, born August 30, 1962. She was a little girl of 4 pounds 15 ounces, being six weeks premature. Patricia was his pride and joy. Today she is a Cardiac Rehab nurse at Waukesha Memorial Hospital.

Upon his retirement, Darrell moved to Arizona. Shortly after the move, another person came into his life, Alan Davies, his beloved son-in-law. Alan is also in the nursing profession, as the Emergency Services Coordinator at Aurora

Summit. Darrell enjoyed many years of retirement in the Sun Cities area, and he was involved in many volunteer projects. No matter who it was or what project they were doing, Darrell was always there to help and give his all.

On Wednesday, March 21, 2012, the Lord decided it was time for Darrell to come home to be with Him. Darrell accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior at an early age, and has served Him in many ways. He was on the Evangelism Committee, taught Sunday School, sang in the choir and the Men's Chorus, fed the homeless at a shelter and served as an Usher.
