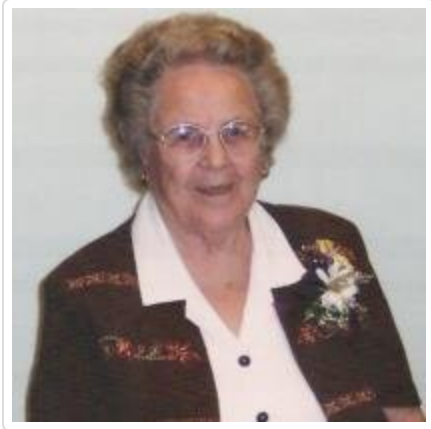




Gladys Elizabeth Krahn
