



## Henry W. Nehls

April 15, 1925 - August 24, 2012

Henry (Heine) W. Nehls, Jr. , of Juneau, passed away Friday, August 24, 2012 at Clearview Nursing Home. He was born in the Town of Oak Grove on April 15, 1925, the son of Henry and Marie (nee Kuenzi) Nehls. Henry married Alice Graycarek in March 1979 in Las Vegas. He worked at John Deere Horicon Works for 33 years, retiring in 1982, after which he worked mowing lawns at Nehls Brothers. Henry and his wife Alice wintered in Arizona for many years, and lived in Beaver Dam during the summer months.

He served our country in the United States Army during World War II from 1943-1946, during the liberation of Europe, serving in areas of Belgium, France and Germany. Henry was a lifetime member of the IAM Local 873, a member of the Juneau American Legion Post 15 and member of St. John's Ev. Lutheran Church Juneau.

Henry is survived by his sister Charlotte Schmidt of Juneau, his brother Franklin Nehls of Brillion, sisters-in-law Celia Nehls of Fond du Lac and Adeline Nehls of Juneau. He is further survived by nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

Henry was preceded in death by his wife Alice in 1996, his parents, his sister Frieda Brakob, his brothers Douglas Nehls and Melvin Nehls, his brothers-in-law Louis Brakob and Fred Schmidt and his sister-in-law Pearl Nehls.
