Jean A. Ninmann, of Hustisford passed away at Aurora Medical Center in Hartford on February 2, 2012, following a short illness at the age of 76 years. Born May 12, 1935 in Hustisford, to Hubert and Edna (Brazelton) Falkenthal. Jean graduated from Hustisford High School and married Howard Ninmann on February 4, 1953.
