Jerrold H. Schultz of Beaver Dam passed away on Wednesday, September 5, 2012, at the Meriter Hospital in Madison due to heart complications, at the age of 70 years. He was born September 15, 1941 in Beaver Dam, to Edward and Lorraine (nee Schroeder) Schultz. During his younger years, Jerry attended St. John's Ev. Lutheran grade school in Juneau and graduated from Juneau high school. He was active in 4H, FFA and was in the Juneau high school color guard. He also attended UW-Madison for Agricultural studies, a short course on farming.

Jerry lived and farmed (the former Ervin Fehling farm) just south of Juneau. On September 26, 1970, Jerry married Sharon LaMue at the Pella Lutheran Church in Waupun. After the sudden death of his wife, in 2008, he moved into Juneau. He continued working at Aunt Nellie's canning factory and lastly at Pivot Point in Hustisford. His many nieces and nephews adored him and enjoyed his wonderful sense of humor and sharp wit. He became an avid sports fan in his later years, always making sure that ESPN was available. His generous nature and willing spirit will be greatly missed.
