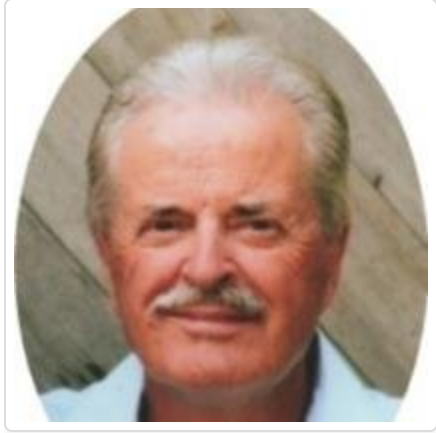




John thomas Kraker
