Joseph M. Quick, 80, passed away peacefully on the morning of April 2, 2012, in Kissimmee, Florida. He was enjoying his annual winter vacation, which he loved so very much, when God called him home.

Joseph was born on June 26, 1931 in Hartford, the son of Frank and Theresa (nee Gehl) Quick. He graduated from Hartford High School in 1949. Joseph attended Marquette University until his studies were interrupted by service in the US Army. He was stationed in Fairbanks, Alaska. When he returned from Alaska, he married his high school sweetheart, Patricia Callahan, on October 10, 1953.

Joe owned and operated Joe Quick's Standard Service for 10 years. He then worked for the Washington County Sheriff's Department for 24 years, retiring as a Detective, a job he loved. Prior to his retirement, Joe established "Joe Quick Realty," which kept him active building homes and selling real estate until only recently.

His faith was important to him, and he was proud to be a member of the Knights of Columbus. Joe was involved in the community, serving as a city alderman and volunteering at the Wisconsin Automotive Museum. He was also a member of the American Legion.

Aside from his undying faith, his family meant everything to him. Joe enjoyed spending time with his children and grandchildren; he delighted in doing things for them. They will cherish the many memories and special times they shared with him.

Joe is survived by his wife, his children Frank (Mary) Quick of Fond du Lac, Michael (Debbie) Quick of West Bend, Kathleen Quick (Mark) Schneider of Onalaska and Steve (Kris) Quick of Austin, TX, his grandchildren Betsy, Michael, Erin, Timothy, Robert, Lucia and Peter, and his sister-in-law Vivian Quick.
