Kevin L. Will, of Hustisford, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, August 24, 2015, in Hustisford, WI at the age of 56. He was born July 29, 1959, in Hartford, WI, the son of Carl and Betty (Hackbarth) Will. He was baptized on August 9, 1959 and confirmed on April 8, 1973 at St. Matthew's Catholic Church in Neosho, WI. Kevin was a lifelong member of St. Matthew's.

Kevin, or better known as "Weeble," was an avid hunter and fisherman who knew more secret hunting and fishing locations than anyone else in Wisconsin. He loved spending time in the woods and around the campfire with family and close friends in Buffalo County and by Lake Sharon, especially when wearing camo and Weeble's signature long-johns. Kevin was especially proud to guide and watch each of his children get their first buck.

Kevin was active in softball and bowling leagues in Hustisford and was a member of Hustisford Jaycees and Ducks Unlimited for many years. storytelling, and natural ability to make people laugh.
